The first **European Workshop on Maritime Systems Resilience and Security (MARESEC)** is dedicated to the research on Resilience, Security, Technology and related Ethical, Legal, and Social Aspects (ELSA) in the context of Maritime Systems, including but not restricted to (Offshore/Onshore) Infrastructures, Navigation and Shipping and Autonomous Systems. The intention of this workshop is to bring together researchers to present new results and ongoing projects as well as to exchange experiences and explore possible cooperation.

Prospective authors are invited to submit an extended abstract (1 page, prepared for double-blind process, IEEE style), which will be reviewed by the program committee. Selected authors will be then invited for oral presentation and, optionally, submission of a full paper (4-6 pages), which will go through a further review process, to be published in the workshop proceedings. High quality papers will be invited to submit an extended version to the *WMU Journal of Maritime Affairs* for publication in line with the Journal's reviewing policy.
